The FIG AER-TC wishes to notify our Member Federations of the following information.

< INFORMATION >

The FIG AER-TC appreciates all the valuable feedback received from the NF's on the draft of the CoP 2025-2028. Every feedback was very helpful and has been taken into consideration and discussed at the TC meeting.

The AER-TC visited a session of the European Championship 2023 and tested live judging with the CoP 2025-2028. With those final clarifications, the CoP is on the way to be finalized and to be approved by the FIG EC meeting in February 2024.

We had the opportunity to share some views about the future of our discipline with the European Gymnastics AER-TC. The FIG AER-TC feels that it is important to gather with all the Continental AER-TC to share the same information around the world. We will plan some online meetings in coming year.

The FIG AER-TC made the proposal to the FIG EC to increase the number of entries for IM and IW (in the Senior and Junior categories only) to 3 entries per NF for the AER World Championships 2024. The proposal was approved at the FIG EC meeting in Dhaka, BAN.

< Clarifications & Reminder >

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< Women's Attire – Transparent material allowed for sleeves >

A correct gymnastics leotard must be made of non-transparent material; **therefore, leotards that have some parts made of lace (transparent material) will need to be lined (from the trunk to the chest).** Transparent material (transparency) is allowed only for sleeves of Women's attire.

< Uniform vs Costume > see Competition Clothing and Advertising Rule, Introduction.

Uniforms for FIG competitions must follow the rules set out in the Olympic Charter and the principles set out in the FIG Code of Ethics. These documents indicate that clothing designs are expected to be compatible as a **sport uniform and not a costume.**

Uniform = Leotard



Costume = Clothing that is used to masquerade





< Design >

The uniform design may not include any political slogans or signs, motivational words or logos. Designs or items depicting war, violence, sexual or religious themes are forbidden and will receive penalties according to the Code of Points.

< Loose and Additional Item; 2.3.C.5 >

Loose and additional items to the attire are not allowed.

Decorative appliques or details (ex: different type of sequins, stones, embroidered or lace) on the leotard are allowed but **must be securely sewed to the leotard** that they do not move while performance.

It is also **not allowed** to decorate the leotard with light-emitting diodes (LED lights). As mentioned in the NL #2 (May 2022), when appearing on the stage with your attire, you **must leave the stage the same**.

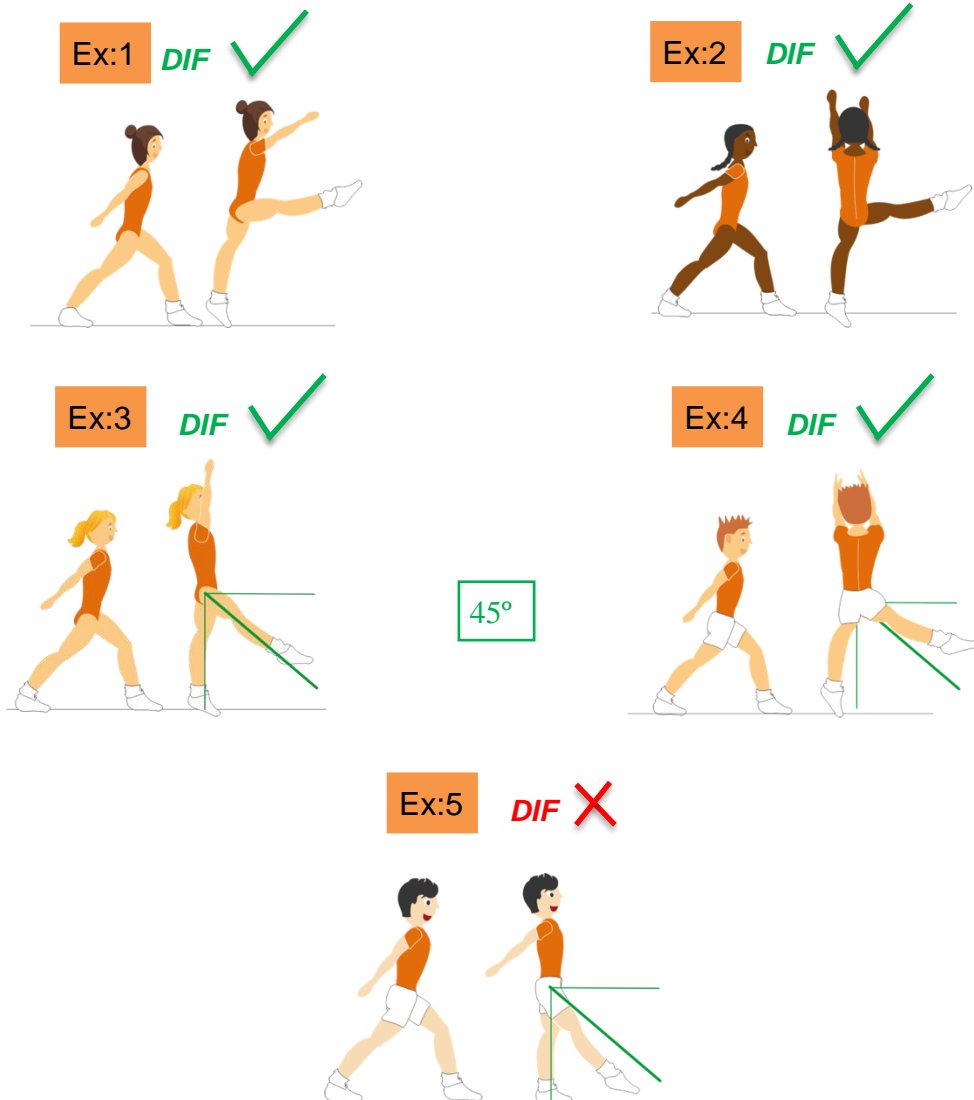
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< Minimum Requirement >

Minimum requirement for **Family 6; Scissors Leap and Switch Split Leap:**

- The leading leg must be minimum 45° above parallel **regardless the body orientation**.
